





An Introduction



Your Local Hospice



East Cheshire Hospice has been providing essential care and support to adults facing life limiting illnesses for almost 30 years.

Based in Macclesfield, the Hospice supports patients and families in Handforth, Knutsford, Wilmslow, Buxton, Congleton, Poynton, Holmes Chapel, and all the villages and hamlets in between. We serve a population of 200,000 and an area of 440 square miles.



Inpatient care

Our 15 bed inpatient unit provides end of life care for people with a wide range of diagnoses, including cancer, heart disease, lung conditions and neurological problems. It is open 24 hours, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Sunflower Wellbeing Centre

We also offer day care in our Sunflower Centre which provides therapeutic support to people from the point of diagnosis. Fully staffed with trained palliative nurses, the Centre offers outpatient appointments as well as group sessions.



We support and care for friends, families and loved ones, not just for our patients.

We have a patient centred and holistic approach, which means patients have access to a wide range of therapies and treatments, such as physiotherapy, complementary therapies, chaplaincy and counselling services, Art Psychotherapy and bereavement support.



How we are funded

We are a charity and all of the services we provide are free of charge. We receive only 17% of our funding from the NHS, which leaves us with a gap of £7,500 every day. We need to raise this money through donations and other support in order to maintain our high standards of care to those who are in great need.

We carry out a wide range of different fundraising activities throughout the year. We are so lucky to have the support of so many of our local community, who fundraise for us and volunteer with us.
