1. What is Will Week?

From 5th-9th October 2020, East Cheshire Hospice will be holding our annual Will Week, during which local solicitors kindly donate their time and expertise to support the charity. In return for a donation to the Hospice, during Will Week you can get your Will written and the solicitor will waive their usual fees.

2. Where can I find the list of solicitors taking part?

A full list of participating solicitors is available on our website, eastcheshirehospice.org.uk/willweek20 and is also included our leaflets in the community.

3. How do I book an appointment?

To book an appointment, please contact the solicitor of your choice directly who will be able to offer you a date and time.

4. Where will the appointment take place?

All appointments will take place at the solicitor's offices advertised on our website. All appointments will be subject to social distancing guidelines as outlined by the government at the time of your appointment. If this is not possible, your solicitor will advise you what regulations they have put in place, this may include protective screens.

5. What services will the solicitor provide?

Participating solicitors will be able to write a single or mirror will, or update your will, in return for a donation to the Hospice. Any services above and beyond this will be chargeable at the solicitor's usual cost.

6. How much am I expected to donate?

At the time of booking your appointment, your solicitor will outline their usual fee's and encourage you to donate a similar amount to the Hospice in return for the service. Please remember the solicitors are kindly donating their time free of charge to help raise funds for the Hospice.

7. How do I make my donation?

At the time of your appointment your solicitor will provide you with an East Cheshire Hospice donation envelope. Please bring the amount you would like to donate in cash or cheque to the appointment as you will be asked to donate at this initial appointment.

8. What if the solicitor I want has ran out of appointments?

Appointments are limited this year due the current pandemic, please contact our Corporate Fundraiser Kate on 01652 665 694 who will be able to suggest an alternative solicitor for you. Alternatively, please check back on our website for an updated list of solicitors. Early booking is advised.

9. Where will my money go?

All the money donated during Will Week will be given directly to East Cheshire Hospice by your solicitor. As a local charity, East Cheshire Hospice relies on the generosity of our community to pay for more than 80% of our costs, so you can be sure that your donation will make a real difference to our patients and their families.
