### Key information—Tough Woofer

#### Before Tough Woofer Fundraise



- Use this Fundraising Pack to help you with ideas to ensure you raise as much money as possible for the Hospice
- Set up an online sponsorship page through <u>www.JustGiving.com/campaign./toughwoofer19</u>, it is a quick and easy way to get started; you can send the link to your page to family, friends, colleagues, clients and suppliers

#### <u>On the day</u> Know your Wave Start Time

- There will be lots of individuals and dogs taking part in Tough Woofer on Sunday 20th October and we will be setting participants off in ten minute intervals
- The first wave will commence at 10.00am, with consecutive waves leaving every 10mins, so be sure to arrive in plenty of time
- You will receive an email from the events team two weeks prior to the event confirming your wave start time

# Your official Tough Woofer t-shirt and dog neckerchief is included in your registration fee. Please see below the collection dates for T-shirt and Neckerchief collection here at the Hospice:

Please don't worry if you can't collect your T shirt/s or neckerchief from the Hospice, you will need to register your attendance on the day of the event anyway and you pick up your t-shirt, dog neckerchief and wristband at the same time.

#### Gates open

- Registration will be open from 9.00am onwards
- Please ensure you arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to your wave start time to register your attendance and receive a t-shirt, neckerchief and wristband if you haven't already collected them
- You should be ready at the start area no more than ten minutes prior to your allocated wave start time
- Limited car parking is available on site so we suggest car sharing where possible

#### Charity Village

- There will be a bag drop off point, toilets, changing area, vet cover and first aid in the village
- There will be entertainment throughout the day
- Merchandise Stalls to purchase from
- Hot and Cold food and drink available to purchase
- Family friendly activities including mini agility course, doggy shower, pampering area and more

#### Gates close

- You are ready to make your way home when you have completed the course, or you are welcome to enjoy our Charity Village
- When you are ready please return to your car safely and make your way home. Please ensure you and your dog are fully hydrated before leaving
- Take a moment to reflect; you have been part of a brilliant event and by taking part and raising sponsorship you have raised vital funds for patient care at East Cheshire Hospice

#### After Tough Woofer

- If you do not get handed a medal/s at the finish line, please remember to collect them from the medals desk before leaving the charity village
- Please collect your sponsorship money and return it to the Hospice as soon as you possibly can

# Here are five top tips to get your fundraising off to a flying start!

#### 1. Set up an online giving page

An easy and quick way to start raising sponsorship is by setting up an online giving page via **www.justgiving.com/campaign/toughwoofer19**. Follow their simple steps and any donations made on your page will come directly to East Cheshire Hospice.

#### 2. Tell your friends and family

Now you've set up your fundraising page, it's time to tell your friends and family! Any donations made via your online sponsorship page come directly to the Hospice and you can quickly and easily send the link to your family, friends and colleagues anywhere in the world! You can also put the link on your Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn pages to encourage friends to support you.

#### 3. Don't forget to ask for Gift Aid

If your donors a UK Tax Payer, ask them to tick the Gift Aid box. This means that East Cheshire Hospice can claim an extra 25p for every pound donated.

#### 4. Ask your workplace to support you

Many companies offer matched giving programmes and will double the amount you raise.

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# **Frequently asked questions**

#### When and Where is Tough Woofer?

It is on Sunday 20th October from 9.00am in the grounds of Capesthorne Hall, Congleton Rd, Siddington, Macclesfield SK11 9JY.

#### Is there parking?

Yes, parking is available on site from 09:00am. We strongly advise that you car share where possible.

#### What time am I starting?

It depends on what 10min wave start time you have been given. You will be notified by email 2weeks prior to the event with your allocated time.

#### Is there an age limit for taking part?

All human participants must be aged 8 years or over on the day of the event. Dogs must be 1 year or over. Participants aged 8-15years on the day must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18. Human participants taking part with a dog must be able to control the dog on a lead at ALL times.

#### Are spectators permitted?

Yes, spectators will be able to walk between obstacles out on the course and allowed access to the charity village. There is a £5 charge per spectator.

#### What is in the Charity Village?

You will find the registration point, start and finish areas, information tent, bag drop off, toilets, changing area, vet cover, first aid, a washing area, pampering area, water stations, other family friendly activities, merchandise stalls and hot and cold food contractors. There will also be entertainment throughout the day.

#### What should I wear?

Your Tough Woofer t-shirt, plus some sensible shoes. Please remember Tough Woofer is an outdoor event, so it is essential you come prepared for the English weather! Tough Woofer will involve participants getting wet, muddy and potentially cold, please come prepared with a change of clothes and towel if necessary.

#### Can I take part with more than one dog?

No, our rules state that only one dog per human participant is allowed.

### My dog does not like being on a lead, can we still take part?

No, our rules state that dogs, whether participating or spectating must be kept on a lead at ALL times. Due to the number of dogs taking part, all dogs must be sociable around other dogs.

# Can we skip obstacles if they are unsuitable or too difficult?

Our priority is for all participants to enjoy the event. If you or your dog are struggling or having problems with an obstacle, then it is not necessary to complete it. You can walk around all obstacles or move on to the next one.

# Why do you ask participants to raise sponsorship?

The entrance fee only covers the cost of the event. You will also receive a T-shirt, dog neckchief and medals. We do ask that everyone tries to raise at least £30 of sponsorship. Every penny you raise goes directly towards providing Hospice care in your local community.
