Bringing our care into your home when you need it most



Given the choice, most of us would like to spend our final days in a place where we feel most at home. However, for many people this is not possible, due to limited resources which can lead to unwanted admissions to hospital.

We believe that people with a life limiting illness should have the choice to receive care wherever they feel most comfortable. East Cheshire Hospice @Home has been developed to try and give end of life patients more choice and control. Our aim is to empower people to remain at home if they wish to, by offering high quality end of life care and support in the community.

How can we help?

The Hospice @Home team is made up of experienced specialist nurses and highly trained healthcare assistants, who can offer hands on practical and nursing support, to enable patients and their families who are coping with an end of life situation to remain at home whenever possible.

Our main role is to provide support in a number of ways when other services may be limited.

We've been serving the East Cheshire community for around 30 years, and we have the knowledge and expertise to deliver end of life care effectively and compassionately. We will also provide support and care for your family, carers and other loved ones.



Our services

Rapid Response

Our Rapid Response service offers out of hours support, providing symptom management, urgent care needs and psychological support to the patient.

Hours of operation:

Monday to Friday 9pm-8am

24/7 weekends and bank holidays

Day Service

Our Hospice @Home Day Service is a planned package of care referred by Cheshire NHS Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG) for Continuing Healthcare (CHC) allowing us to provide up to 4 visits per day.

Hours of operation:

7 days per week 7.30am - 9:30pm

Carer Break

Infrequent visits or ad hoc care/carers' breaks.

7 days per week 7.30am - 9:30pm

What can we offer?


