Drive in Cinema- FAQ

Will there be food to buy on site?

Yes! We have Pizza Principles on site to make you freshly made pizzas on site ready for you to enjoy whilst you watch your film/s.

Will there be toilet facilities on site?

Yes

Do we need to use our Car radios to hear the film?

No! You will be given a box radio on arrival and the film's audio will be played out of from inside your car, so no need to keep your engines running.

Can we sit outside of our cars when the film starts?

No. for the safety of everyone on site we ask you stay inside your cars for the entirety of the film, unless you are leaving to use the toilets or to purchase food.

Does is matter if we have a bigger car? Where will we be parked?

No, as long as your car is below 2 meters in height. However, you will be parked by a team of marshals on arrival, and taller cars may be positioned in a section nearer the back to ensure that smaller cars are able to see. You will still be able to see the film at all times, so it won't affect your evening. Please note that we reserve the right to turn you away if your vehicle exceeds these height restrictions and we take no responsibility if you choose not to follow this guidance.

Q. How many people can we have in a car?

A. Everyone must have a seat with a seat belt, tickets are sold per car.

Q. Can I open my car window during the showings?

A. Yes everyone will be spaced 2m apart.

Q. Can I bring my dog?

A. Unfortunately, no dogs are allowed on site, unless they are a service dog.

Q. What COVID-19 restrictions will be in place?

- A. Cars will be spaced 2m apart.
 - Queues for food will and drinks will be spaced 1m apart.
 - Masks are no longer a requirement and are optional to wear when waiting in queues.
 - Hand sanitising stations will be available.

Can we watch both films?

Yes! There is an option at a special price of £35 watch both films throughout the evening if you wish. Please note you will not be able to move your vehicle from its space after the first film.
