Starlight Walk Itinerary

Before the Starlight Walk

- Use this Fundraising Pack to help you with ideas to ensure you raise as much money as possible for the Hospice.
- Set up an online sponsorship page by <u>clicking here</u>. It is a quick and easy way to get started; you can send the link to your page to family, friends, colleagues, clients and suppliers.

On the night

6:00pm Gates open

- Car parking available
- Registration opens
- Activities available, including glitter face painting, tombola and collecting your remembrance pebble
- Hospice pop-up stalls
- Find out more about our Memory Tree
- Live entertainment and music on stage
- Hot & cold food available to purchase

7:00pm And you're off!

- With a choice of loops around the grounds, you can choose the distance which suits you; 2.5km, 5km, 7.5km or 10km
- Use our reflective areas around the fire pit
- Once you have dropped your remembrance pebble over the bridge, follow the route back to the event village.
- Music and activities will continue throughout the night
- Last walker will set off at 10:00pm

10:15pm Welcome back

- Stop for a photo as you're welcomed over the finish line
- Collect your gift from our volunteers If you want to keep walking the route, let our team of volunteers know and you can collect your medal once you are finished

10:30pm Thank you and goodnight

- Please return to your car safely and make your way home
- Take a moment to reflect; you have been part of a very important event that has raised vital funds for patient care at East Cheshire Hospice

Top Fundraising Tips!

As your entrance fee only covers the cost of the event we do ask that everyone tries to raise at least £50 of sponsorship. Every penny you raise goes directly towards providing Hospice care and your sponsorship really does make a huge difference in helping us to continue to provide care in your local community.

Alternatively, we ask for you to make a donation to the Hospice of £50.

Here are five top tips to get your fundraising off to a flying start!

1. Set up an online fundraising page

An easy and quick way to start raising sponsorship is by setting up a JustGiving page by <u>clicking here</u>. Follow their simple steps and any donations made on your page will come directly to East Cheshire Hospice.

2. Tell your friends and family

Now you've set up your fundraising page, it's time to tell your friends and family! Any donations made via your online sponsorship page come directly to the Hospice and you can quickly and easily send the link to your family, friends and colleagues anywhere in the world! You can also put the link on your Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and LinkedIn pages to encourage friends to support you.

3. Don't forget to ask for Gift Aid

If your donors a UK Tax Payer, ask them to tick the Gift Aid box. This means that East Cheshire Hospice can claim an extra 25p for every pound donated.

4. Ask your workplace to support you

Many companies offer matched giving programmes and will double the amount you raise.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the Starlight Walk taking place?

It is taking place in the grounds of Capesthorne Hall, Siddington, Macclesfield, Cheshire SK11 9JY.

Is there parking?

Parking is available on-site and is free of charge. Please car share where possible.

Do I need a torch?

Yes, the Starlight Walk will begin at dusk and the grounds of Capesthorne Hall are only partially lit, so a torch with fresh batteries is essential.

Can I camp?

Camping is available on-site, the caravan park has 50 pitches, with electric hook up and a facilities block. For more information contact Capesthorne Hall directly at www.capesthorne.com or 01625 861221.

Is there food and drink available on the night?

Yes, there will be caterers serving a variety of food and drink that you can purchase throughout the evening. BBQs are not allowed.

Are there activities taking place on the night?

Yes, there will activities for all ages and things to buy at the stalls, please see our website for up-to- date information.

What is the wristband for?

You will be given a wristband on the night, it is very important that you wear your wristband; we need it to register and deregister you at the event.

What should I wear?

We are encouraging participants to wear their favourite Memory Walk t-shirt from over the years... If you don't have one don't worry! But it is essential you wrap up warm and come prepared for the English weather!

Do I need sensible shoes?

Yes, there is some uneven terrain and unmarked pathways, so sturdy, comfortable walking shoes, trainers or wellies are appropriate.

Should I bring a waterproof?

Yes, we would recommend bringing a coat; the British weather is very changeable and so if it looks like rain please come prepared.

Is the Hospice on Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter?

Yes, we add regular updates and photos so please and share and like our posts. And don't forget to use #starlightwalk24

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, your family pet is very welcome on the night; they are your full responsibility, they must be kept on a lead at all times, and you must clear up any dog foul.





What if I can't come?

If for any reason you are unable to attend the walk please let the fundraising team know as soon as possible by calling 01625 433477.

Can I volunteer?

Yes, if you are not taking part we would be very grateful for your help at the event. We rely on our volunteers to help us in a number of different roles including route marshalling, registration, refreshments, car parking, set-up and clear- down. Contact the fundraising team on the details below to find out more.

I don't feel fit enough to take part?

You don't need to train for this event, it is a very relaxed atmosphere. If you don't want to walk, you are welcome to stay and explore the event village.

I am nervous about crowds and covid-19?

The event is completely outdoors. Please wear a mask if this makes you feel more comfortable. There will be plenty of space to spread out from the crowds.

I think I might have covid-19 can I still come to the event?

Although laws state that you no longer need to self-isolate, if you have or think you have covid-19, we kindly ask that you stay at home. Participant, volunteer, supplier and staff safety is our first priority

Will there be t-shirts this year?

We are not doing t-shirts this year as we are trying to be kinder to the environment and always have so many left over. We are embracing t-shirt nostalgia and encouraging participants to wear their favourite memory walk t-shirt from over the years.

Can I bring alcohol?

A licenced bar will be available on site, so we ask you to please not bring your own alcohol.

Is the route pushchair and wheelchair friendly?

There are no stiles on route but the ground is very uneven and muddy in places so we wouldn't recommend pushchairs or wheelchairs.

East Cheshire Hospice is not just a building – it's a group of volunteers, clinicians and supporters who help to deliver exceptional end of life care to patients and their families.
