LITERACY

Design a Dream Bed

Let imaginations soar as students design their ultimate hospital bed – comfy, creative, even futuristic!

💡 Fundraising Tip: Display in a “Dream Ward” gallery and invite parents in to school to make a donation.



ART/DT

Bed Mural

Ask for donations of old bed sheets for students to create wonderful artwork on. Make it meaningful and beautiful, try to connect it to the Hospice as much as you can.

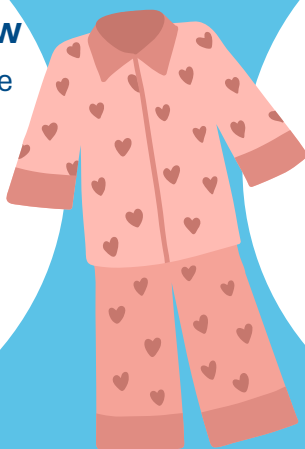
💡 Competition: The best ones will be displayed at East Cheshire Hospice and shared on our socials.

ART/DESIGN

PJ Design & Fashion Show

Students could design and make a set of pyjamas then hold a fashion show for all to see.

💡 Fundraising Tip: Charge an entry fee or sell the creations



TEXTILES/DRAMA

Movie Wind-Down

End the day with a calm, PJ-friendly film screening.

💡 Fundraising Tip: Ask for a “cinema ticket” donation



CHILLTIME

Bedtime Bingo or Quiz

Create a fun quiz or bingo game themed around sleep, health or the Hospice.

💡 Fundraising Tip: Entry fee 50p-£1 with small prizes for winners.

GENERAL STUDIES

Build a Mini Bed

Use recyclables to engineer mini beds – test them for comfort and stability!

💡 Top Tip: Combine with a design showcase or judging panel.



STEM/DT

Sweet Dreams Bake Sale

Host a bake-sale at breaktime/ after school for students, parents and staff to enjoy - donations for the Hospice.

FOOD TECH

Sleep & Wellbeing Workshop

A short, age-appropriate talk on why sleep matters – and how hospices help people rest and feel safe. Students could write or draw something kind for hospice patients or staff.

💡 Fundraising Tip: No direct ask -adds purpose to the day.
